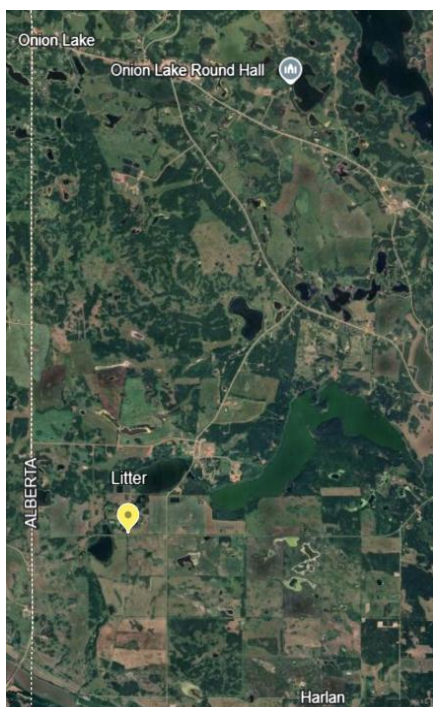
## Cash Rewards of up to \$2000

*A cash reward is being offered for information leading to the arrest or conviction of the individuals involved. Anyone with information about this crime should contact the provincial toll-free Turn In Poachers and Polluters (TIPP) line. Calls are not traced or recorded in any way and callers may choose to remain anonymous.*

**On April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2026, Lloydminster Conservation Officers located several items that were unlawfully disposed of along grid 797, north of Harlan, SK.**

**Conservation Officers observed articles of men’s clothing ranging in sizes from XL and XXL, women’s clothing, two medium size duffle bags, personal belongings such as toiletries and other household garbage. Specific evidence located by the officers included an Onion Lake Minor Hockey Association medal 2014-15, and an article with the name Jaron.**

**Although evidence was collected at the scene, Conservation Officers are requesting the public’s assistance in locating the individual(s) involved.**
